- Orders TEE exam in Cerner. Completes demographics in Synchronicity.
- Knows contra-indications: perforated viscous, known esophageal pathology, active UGIB, and recent UGI surgery
- Inserts bite block, places gel in probe cover, and covers probe.
- Inserts probe with correct orientation (considers jaw thrust, 2-person technique, and use of laryngoscope)
- Obtains mid-esophageal 4-chamber view and identifies LA, RA, LV and RV
- Obtains mid-esophageal long-axis view and identifies LA, LV, MV and AV
- Obtains trans-gastric short-axis view and identifies LV, RV, and septum
- Obtains optional other views depending on clinical scenario
- Describes probe removal and sends for sterile processing
- Interprets images in Synchronicity and either assigns attending or signs interpretation and imports into Cerner depending on level of training
- Documents procedure note
